

INDIANA TREE CLIMBING COMPETITION



SECURED FOOTLOCK

The Secured Footlock measures the contestant's ability to perform a vertical ascent into a tree using a specific approved hitch for fall protection and the footlock rope-climbing method on a doubled climbing line. The men climb to 49' 2.5" and the event is timed, with a maximum time limit of 60 seconds, and the contestant with the fastest time wins.
